- May minutes were accepted
- That Spring Thing postcard: Postcards were mailed and received this week. Thank you to Theresa and all involved in creating & mailing them. Due to scarring on the front of some cards after going through the US Mail, it was decided we should use a stronger finish on the surface of the postcard for any future mailing.
- LLNA T-Shirt update: T-Shirts will not be ready in time for That Spring Thing event. A clearer image is needed of the LLNA Logo. Martha will send Steve a clearer image.
- CLC Update: The CLC is moving forward with the herbicide treatment for Long Lake. Notices will be posted as soon as next week regarding the dates when the treatment will take place. A 3-year contract with Lycott Environmental has been signed to achieve 80% control of milfoil, fanwort & curly pond weed lake-wide. This year "sticky pellets" will be used, a time release system that goes down and sticks to the plants, deteriorating their growth. Treatment is intended to be done before the swim season.
- Water Conservation: Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection has a five year plan for every MA resident to abide by a 65 gallon per day/per person limit throughout MA. It is the Littleton Water Department's goal to start water conservation now, to help meet those goals. Starting June 1, 2009 between 7pm and 7am only - Odd days for outdoor watering are Tuesday, Thursday & Saturday. Even days for outdoor watering are Wednesday, Friday and Sunday. No daytime watering allowed. No watering on Mondays. Refer to LLWD website for more details.
- Lowell Spinners: Steve will check on the availability of group game tickets for an evening of baseball.
- Dock Installation: Thank you to everyone who helped flip over and install the docks on the waterfront. Great job!
