

LLNA September 10, 2009 MINUTES

IN ATTENDANCE: Steve Foss, Frank Vigna, Dan Lord, & Jon Folsom

- There was a discussion about the alternate URL for the LLNA website, www.weloveourlake.org, as to whether we should discontinue paying for it.
